

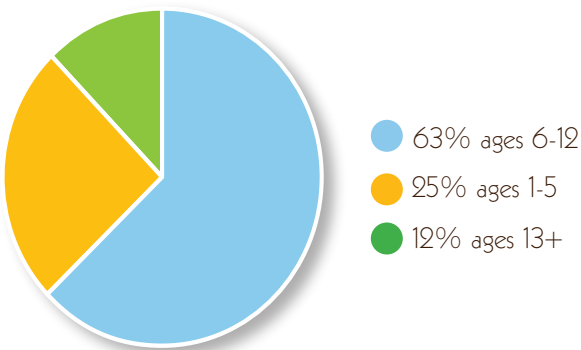

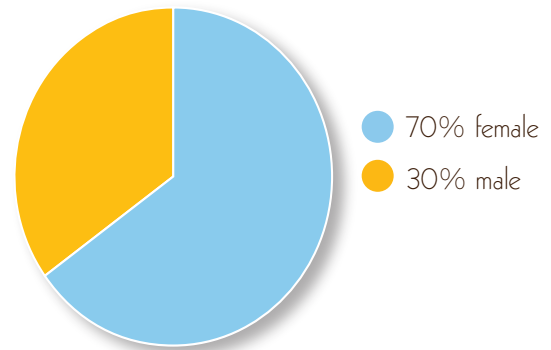


In 2010, **739** children were interviewed at the Center for Child Protection. These are the children that survived to courageously tell someone about their abuse. Over **7,100** services were provided to **3,520** children and adults. The services provided can often mean the difference between living in fear and having the resources to begin a new life. 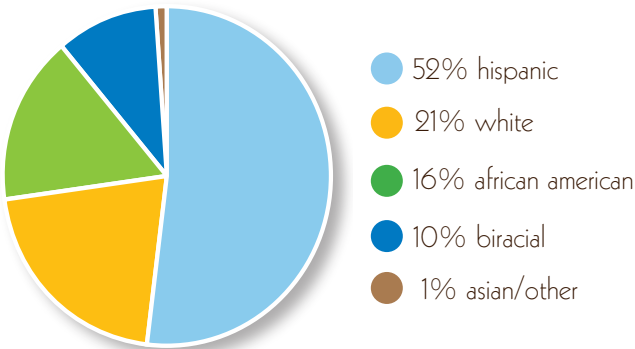
## Age of Children Interviewed



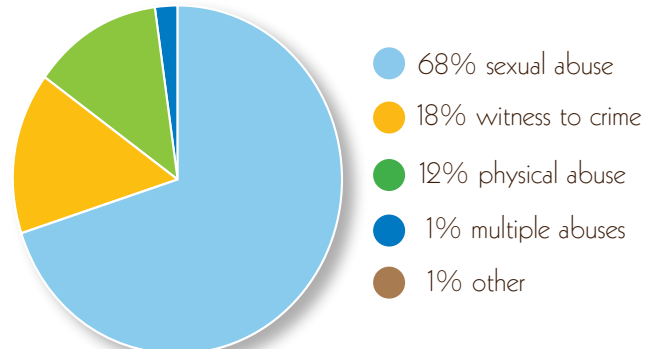
## Gender of Children Interviewed

## Types of Abuse of Children Interviewed

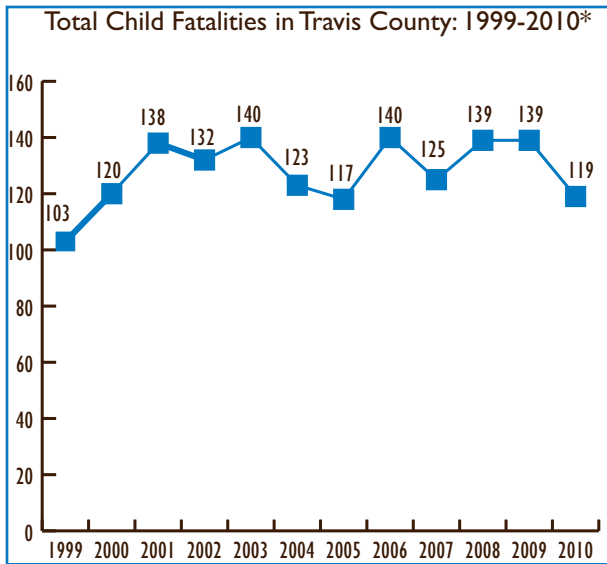

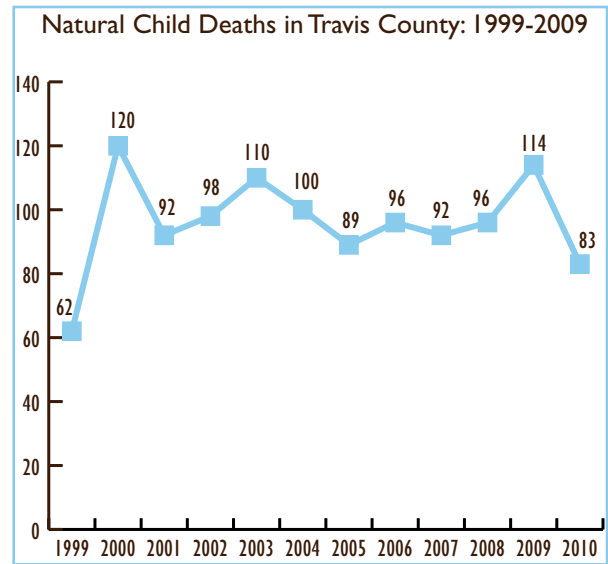
# Travis County Child Fatality Review Team

## 2010 Annual Report

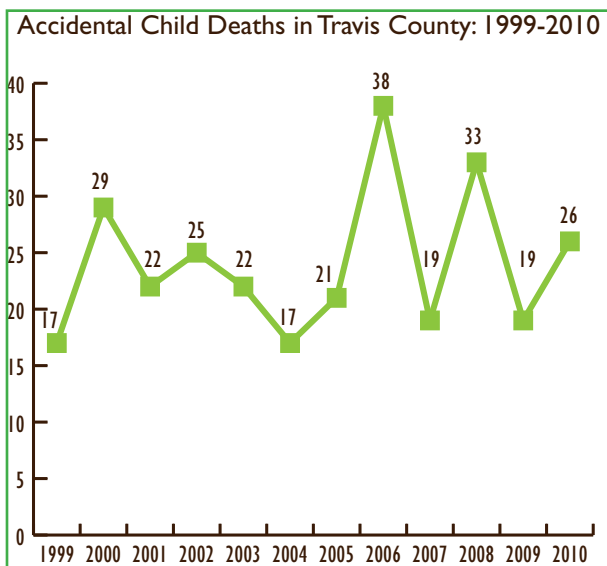
The Travis County Child Fatality Review Team (CFRT) is a multidisciplinary group consisting of law enforcement officials, medical professionals, social workers, prosecutors, and child advocacy professionals working together toward a single goal: to prevent the senseless and needless deaths of children in Travis County.



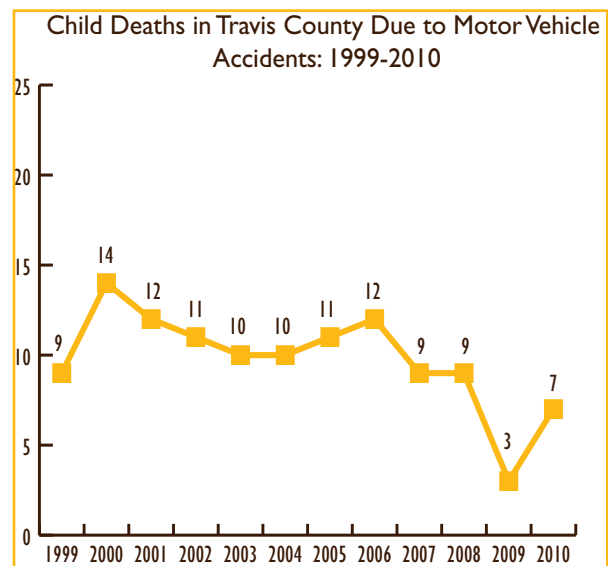
- 68 recorded child fatalities in 2010
- 51% fewer child fatalities than in 2008 & 2009



- 114 children died from natural causes in 2009
- 2010 numbers are not available at this time



- 26 children died from accidental causes in 2010
- 17 children died as a result of unsafe sleeping environments



- 7 children died in traffic accidents in 2010
- An increase from 2009, but lower than all previous years tracked
