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### TRAINING TOPIC

*Stewards of Children*, a training program designed to teach adults how to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. *Stewards of Children* approaches this difficult topic in a way that is empowering and motivating, and it is the only internationally available, evidence-informed program proven to increase knowledge, improve attitudes and change child-protective behaviors. This revolutionary program is free of charge and is designed for any responsible adult who cares about the welfare of children and is particularly appropriate for parents and also for training staff and volunteers of youth-serving organizations and schools.

### YOU WILL LEARN

- The types of situations in which child sexual abuse could occur and simple, effective strategies for protecting children.
- How to talk about the prevention of sexual abuse with children and other adults.
- Signs of sexual abuse and the tools to react responsibly.

### TRAINING DETAILS

- Two 35-minute videos, integrating commentary from sexual abuse survivors, experts in the field and other concerned adults, all providing practical guidance.
- Group discussion about important strategies and barriers in sexual abuse prevention and how they affect communities and youth serving organizations.
- Participants will receive an interactive workbook designed to facilitate discussion, reinforce key concepts, and serve as a resource guide and Personal Action Plan for protecting children in their lives.
