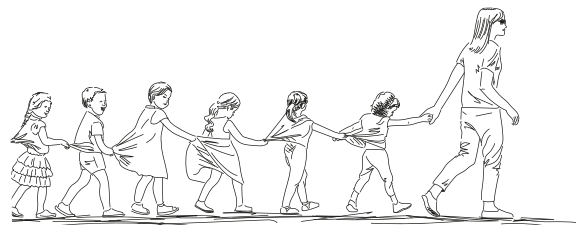

# The Strength of a Team

## FORENSIC INTERVIEWS

1,557 children served at the point of interview – a 16% increase from 2017.

## TEAM RELATIONS

1,790 cases coordinated.

## MEDICAL

727 CARE Exams were provided by Dell Children's Medical Center.

## CLINICAL

\*Combined clinical services (Intake, Therapy and Family Relational Therapy)

2,322 sessions provided to 199 children.

1,692 sessions provided to 164 adults.

## COMMUNITY

589 volunteers dedicated 10,158 hours to support child abuse victims.

4,808 community members educated on child abuse awareness.
