11,462 reports were made for child abuse and neglect in 2020.




In 2020, child abuse reports in Travis County were down by 15%.


This decrease was directly related to the COVID-19 pandemic and children losing access to the teachers, doctors, childcare workers and other professionals that most often report abuse.


