Impact Report

There are many misconceptions about child abuse, but it occurs in every community and across all socioeconomic, religious, and ethnic backgrounds¹. In fact, one in ten children will be sexually abused before their 18th birthday¹ and three out of five children never disclose sexual abuse². These statistics paint a dark picture, but the Center for Child Protection promotes justice, healing, and prevention through comprehensive services, all free of charge to the community we serve.
