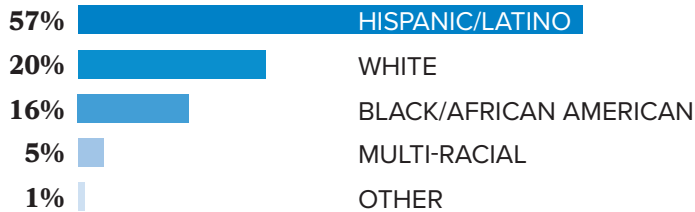

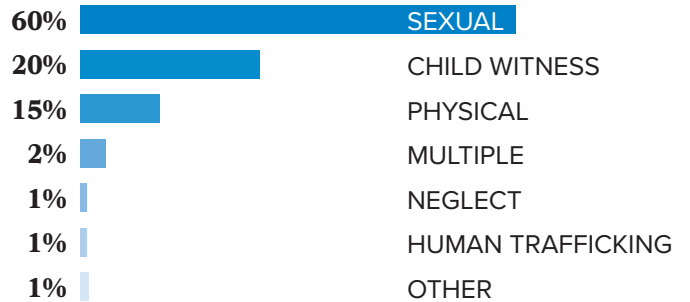

### Ethnicity of Children



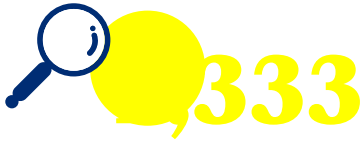

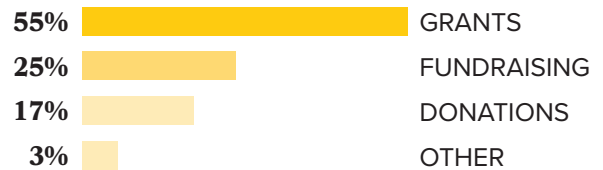
